


Jackson State Community College (JSCC), Computer Information Technology (CIT) program encourages CIT students to compete in competitions that can help students experience real world scenarios in Cyber Security. The Tennessee Board of Regents (TBR) and Cloud Range Cyber, LLC, developed a Pilot Program for TBR community college students to participate in real world cyber attack scenario simulations. The TBR – Cloud Range 2021 Pilot Program allowed students to experience a cyber attack scenario, then to be able to apply skills they had obtained in the Cyber Security curriculum to troubleshoot and defend the cyber attacks. Each student selected two simulations from the program curriculum, which were two hours each. After completing each of the sessions, students completed an assessment on the cyber attack scenario. We had 33 students to participate and complete the pilot program.






